

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

This large, 2 ½-story, Georgian Revival-style, brick dwelling was constructed ca. 1913 for the local chapter of Pi Kappa Alpha national fraternity, which was founded at UVA in 1868. Details include: a gable roof with 3 pediment front dormers; 2 large interior-end brick chimneys; a symmetrical 5-bay front; 1-story, 2-bay porches at each end; brick belt course; bold wooden modillion cornice; front entry shelter with Tuscan columns and pilasters. This handsome Neo-Georgian dwelling was built around 1913 and is a contributing resource in the District.


