

The building was probably built as an outbuilding, and has been adapted to commercial use but remains little-altered on the exterior.

Significance Statement:

This building, which was probably built as an outbuilding, possibly for the boarding house standing on the site of 16 Elliewood Avenue through 1929; or it may have been built to serve the present building at that address. It now functions as a restaurant, and apparently is in operation in conjuction with "Cafe Noelle", standing to the north at 20 Elliewood Avenue (VDHR resource no. 104-133-42) (O'Delī 1983, VHLC n.d., Sanborn 1929, 1941).




