



This house is very similar to that next door and no. 20, and was probably built by and for the same person--perhaps as rental property.

The only major exterior changes include the addition of a sunroom over the front porch, and a modern one-story frame wing on the N end. The frame extension on the S side is also new or recently remodeled (compare with S wing of no. 20).

Just to the north of the house, at the end of the street, is an early six-bay brick garage (no street number).

Description:

Brick two-story building with rectangular form main block, Craftsman and Colonial Revival elements - two-level front porch has Doric columns and balustrade with square wood spindles, second level of porch has been enclosed; windows have shallow segmentally-arched lintels, and roof edge has brackets evoking exposed rafter ends. A second entrance is located immediately south of main entrance, indicating that the dwelling was probably constructed as a duplex.

Condition: Good

Threats to Resource: None Known

Additions/Alterations Description:

Two-story frame section, south wall, either original or built very soon after initial construction; post-1941 one-story frame addition on north side, with shed roof and French doors opening to deck adjoining front porch. Building originally had window blinds, only those on first floor of front facade remain.

Relationship of Secondary Resources to Property:
Large brick garage at rear of property for seven autos, standing in 1929, still there in 1941, and with six sections standing in 1983, no longer survives (O'Dell 1983, Sanborn 1929, 1941).

DHR Historic Context: Commerce/Trade

Significance Statement:

This building was built between 1920 and 1929, apparently as a residence with two living units, one on each floor. It served as a dwelling through 1941; by 1983, it has become "Sir 'N Her" hair salon. It now houses "Willie's Hair

Design". Little-altered, it contributes to the historic district; with the nearly-identical building located to the south at 20 Elliewood Avenue (Cafe Noelle, VDHR resource no. 104-133-42), it represents the change from residential to commercial focus on Elliewood (both of these dwellings may have been built as speculation) (O'Dell 1983; Sanborn 1920, 1921, 1941).




