ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

This house is typical of the Victorian expression in Charlottesville in the last decade of the nineteenth century. The wide gable of the projecting end pavilion is set against the steep, slate hip roof. The high chimney stacks add to teh picturesqueness of the roof forms. The wide veranda with its slender, turned, coupled columns and solid brackets is very Victorian in feeling. The ample brick structure was once painted red and has coupled windows. The interior is a fine example of late nineteenth century edlecticism with robust and imaginative woodwork.

HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION

J. S. McCue purchased the property on the west side of Park Street from the estate of John Cockran in 1890 (DB 2-184). In 1891 he built the large brick Queen Anne house. The property remained in the McCue family until 1907 when Emily H. and Thomas Michie purchased it from the heirs (DB 19-78). In 1928 B. F. Dickerson bought it (DB 58-424), and donated the property to the Home for the Aged which had been located at 201 North First Street. This is built on the original land of Comyn Hall property.
