

This rather unusual Neo Colonial house features true story-and-a-half elevations with dormer windows set partially below the roofline. The house features a corbelled brick cornice and exterior end brick chimneys in the local Virginia 19th-century manner. No. 619 is a one-story rear ell addition.

Historical information

According to the real estate records, one part of this house (or an earlier building) was erected in 1929 and another in 1939. The architectural evidence suggests the main block could have been built as late as 1939.
