Mary Joy,

Public Utilities has been working with our consultant and the vault manufacturer to develop an "Option 4" as requested by the BAR. The new vault will go in the sidewalk between the curb wall and the street. A portion of the curb wall will have to be remove for this installation. Saving the curb wall for replacement is not a practical option, as it is already cracked in several places and the new vault will take the place of the wall footer. The two attached documents should give the BAR a pretty good idea as to what we plan to do.

The wall will be replaced in it's current location. In order to do this, dowels will be installed in the new vault to add support to the wall. The contractor will work with the local concrete supplier to provide a mix that will, as closely as

possible, match the coloring and texture of the existing wall. Inspection of this wall has revealed that several repairs have already been made on this wall since it's original installation.

Please forward this information to BAR for their approval so that we can move forward with the project.

The above referenced project was discussed before a meeting of the City of Charlottesville Board of Architectural Review (BAR) on August 18, 2015. The following action was taken:


The BAR denied (6-1, with Ms. Knott opposed) Option 1, an above-ground vault, and wanted Public Works to investigate Option 4, as described by Laura Knott, to locate the vault beneath the sidewalk; these plans (regarding the removal/replacement of historic curbing at back of sidewalk) would be circulated and approved administratively. If and only if Option 4 is not a viable option, the BAR requests an official explanation as to why it doesn't work, and then they approve either Option 2 or 3 at Public Works' discretion.

In accordance with Charlottesville City Code 34-285(b), this decision may be appealed to the City Council in writing within ten working days of the date of the decision. Written appeals, including the grounds for an appeal, the procedure(s) or standard(s) alleged to have been violated or misapplied by the BAR, and/or any additional information, factors or opinions the applicant deems relevant to the application, should be directed to Paige Barfield, Clerk of the City Council, PO Box 911, Charlottesville, VA 22902.
