FYI - I told you that Martin Roofing is re-fabricating and replacing the large dentil cornice (currently painted metal) and the smaller metal cornice on top of the parapet. You all said they should be white.

Today I met with Marc Bridenhagen with Martin Roofing and also two persons from Moore Masonry. The existing brickwork from the large dentil cornice to the top cornice is also in bad condition. They are planning to repoint it when possible, and rebuild it when necessary, using the same bricks. It will look exactly the same.
