ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

Metal siding; 2 1/2 storey with basement; central hip with gable extending, one dormer; four bays; wrap around porch, one storey. Queen Anne. C. 1880. Standing seam metal roof. Rounded wood shingle siding on gable end. Entrance in second bay from south, sidelights and transom. Second entrance in recessed bay on north side. Lower - south bay nine over nine double sash with storm; third bay from south. Two one over one (side by side) double sash with storm. Upper - two over two double sash. Gable window single sash. Dormer windows two four over four double sash. Four interior chimneys.



This house is considerably bigger than it appears from the street, being at least 3 rooms deep and being entered at abasement level in the rear.

The house features a complex roofline a projecting front ell, and a wraparound veranda.

Historical information

This house was built ca. 1900 for Delia Page, and was used during its early years as a rooming or boarding house for university students.

The Payne family owned it from 1946 to 1966. In 1978 it was purchased by the Beta Alpha House Corp. of Kappa Delta Sorority.



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

Description:

Large frame dwelling with rectangular main block topped by complex hipped roof; projecting two-story gable-roofed section, one bay wide, on southwest side of front facade, with wrap around porch extending across rest of front facade and along northeast side to full-height rear section. Porch has turned wood posts, and rails containing square wood spindles. House has been sided, but fishscale shingles remain in front gable and gabled wall dormer on southwest side wall. Dormers contain small rectangular windows. Main entrance has transom and side lights; secondary entrance, from northeast end of porch into rear section, has paired panelled doors with glazing in the upper halves, and a transom. Inoperable blinds flank most of the windows on the front facade.

Condition: Good-Excellent

Threats to Resource: None Known

Additions/Alterations Description:

The house has been clad with siding, and the gabled section on the front facade has later paired nine-over-nine double hung sash windows on the first floor. A three-story porch on the rear facade, in place in 1969, has been removed; a small one-story side wing, built between 1920 and 1929 on the house's southwest side, was removed between 1941 and 1969 (Sanborne 1913, 1920, 1929, 1941, 1969; O'Dell 1983).

Relationship of Secondary Resources to Property:
By 1920 a one-story outbuilding and small one-story dwelling stood on the property; the outbuilding was removed by 1929, and the dwelling survived through 1969, as 136 1/2 Chancellor Street (Sanborn 1907, 1913, 1920, 1929, 1941, 1969).

DHR Historic Context: Domestic

Significance Statement:

This building first appears on the Sanborn maps in 1907, and was probably built c. 1905; however, it may have been built earlier, c. 1900. It was constructed for Delia Page, and served initially as a rooming house for students. The Payne family owned the property from 1946 to 1966, and in 1978 it was purchased by the Beta Alpha House Corp. of Kappa Delta Sorority. It continues to serve as the Kappa Delta sorority house (Sanborn 1913, 1920, 1929, 1941, 1969; O'Dell 1983). It is an example of vernacular architecture with Colonial Revival design elements, and contributes to the historic district.




