





Three-bay front facade has entrance in northwest end bay, sheltered by shed-roofed hood on wood posts; wood stair on southest side of building leads to second floor.

Brickwork in corners painted over; entrance hood, on brackets in 1983, has been rebuilt on wood posts (O'Dell 1983).




