Two-level parking garage with common-bond brick veneer facing upper level wall on street front; square concrete support piers hold up concrete beams, to support concrete second-level deck (concrete steel-reinforced); metal stair at south corner accesses second level; upper level edged with metal pipe railing at sides; each of the two entrances (from Elliewood Avenue to lower level, from Chancellor Street at upper level) have a simple frame-constructed shed-roofed attendant's booth.

This building does not contribute to the historic district; however, in its scale and use of brick, its design attempts to blend with other buildings nearby on Elliewood Avenue. It stands a site that formerly contained Miss Kelly's boarding house, still standing in 1941 (O'Dell, 1983; Sanborn 1941).

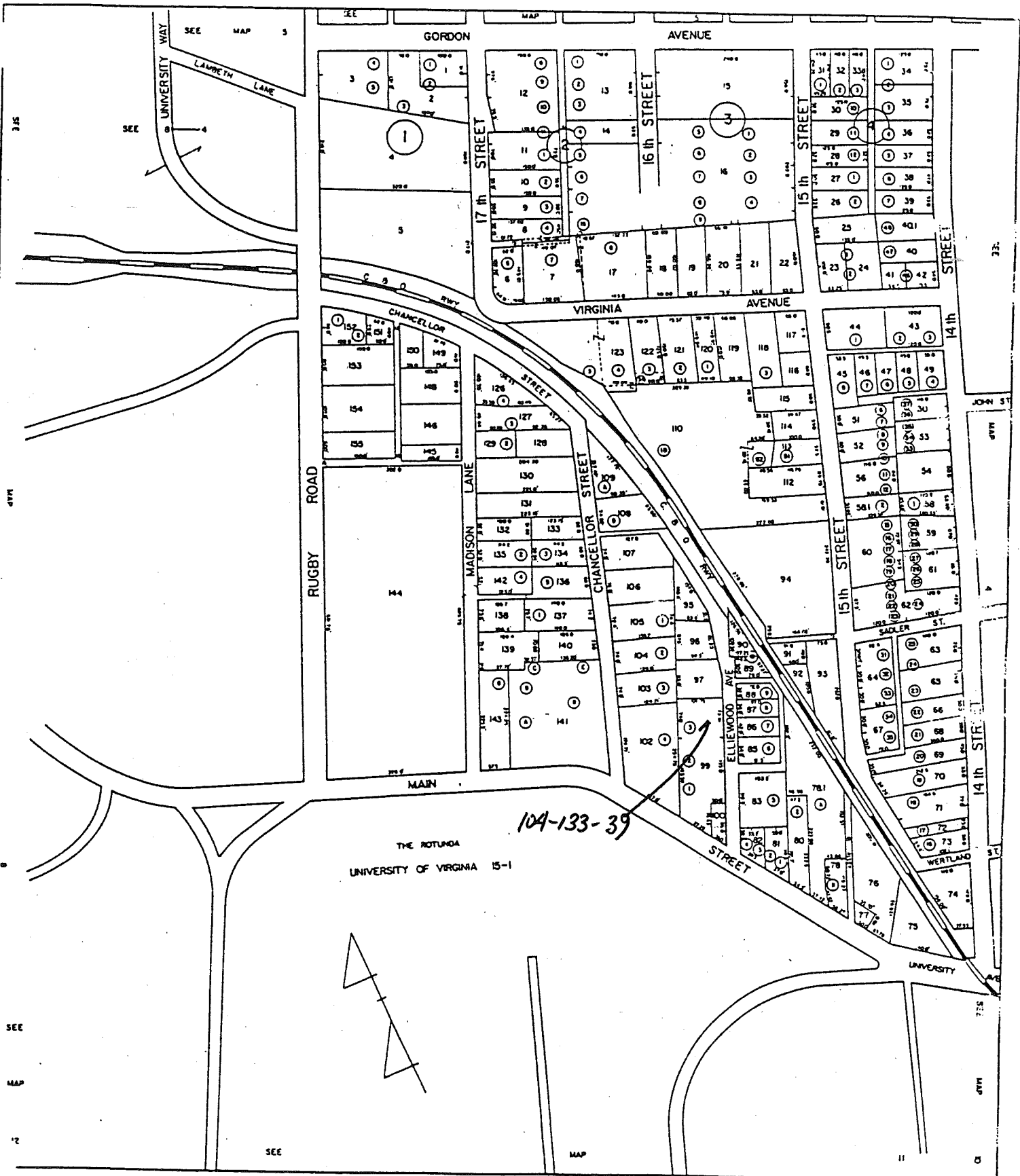
