Description:

This one-story, three-bay, stuccoed frame house is a typical early-twentieth-century dwelling with a single-pile form, topped by a gable roof of asphalt shingles with a center front gable feature. Boxed eaves have simple molding trimwork. An integral one-story ell extends behind the house. The house's foundation is of parged masonry (probably brick). An interior rear flue of parged brick chimney is visible from the street. The one-story, one-bay, shed-roofed front porch has had its supports replaced. The windows throughout the house are six-over-six double-hung wood sash, with molded wood trimwork. The central front entry incorporates a paneled wood and glass door.

Additions/Alterations Description:

Stucco may be an addition to original weatherboard siding; aluminum storms have been added at window and door openings. A rear shed porch has been enclosed. The front porch supports, originally probably wood, have been replaced with wrought metal supports.

Significance Statement:

Built about 1913, upon acquisition of the property by Mary M. Truehart Woodfolk, this house may have been designed and constructed by her husband, Ollie T. Woodfolk, Sr. The Woodfolks apparently lived in the house until they built and moved to their ca. 1922 dwelling at 922 Raymond Road. Mary M.T. Woodfolk retained ownership of this property throughout her life, apparently using it as a rental house after she no longer lived there. Her daughters Marion and Lucille continue to own the house and use it as rental property. The Woodfolk House is typical of the one-story, single-pile dwellings built in the historically African-American neighborhood east of Ridge Street during the early twentieth century.

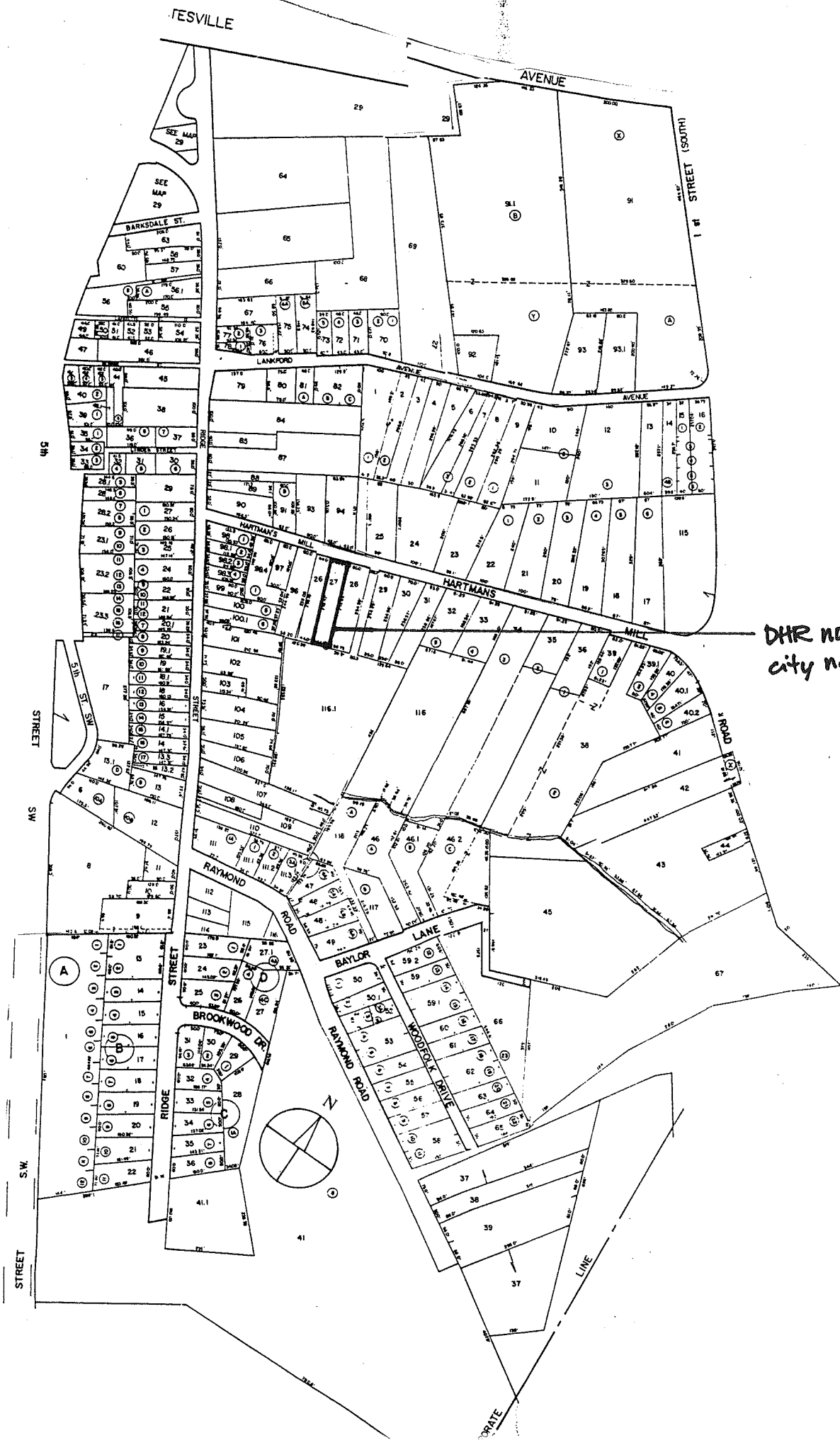

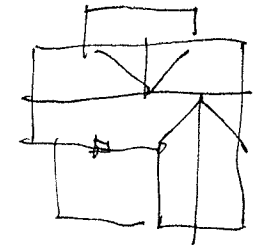
