This one-story, three-bay, aluminum-sided frame house is a typical mid-twentieth-century dwelling with a rectangular form, topped by a side-gable roof with asphalt shingles. The basement foundation, partially above ground at the rear of the building, is of parged concrete blocks. A single, unornamented brick flue is present at the rear roof plane, as is a relatively modern one-story, four-bay screened porch supported by simple square posts. The windows throughout the house are six-over-six double-hung sash. A rear shed wing, built of similar materials and detailing as the rest of the house, extends across the building's full length.

Additions/Alterations Description: Aluminum siding has been added to the walls, and the original roofing has been replaced by asphalt shingles.



Significance Statement:

This property, built about 1939 by developer James L. Fagans concurrently with the houses at 102 Lankford, was acquired at auction in 1940 by G.T. Huff and H.A. Haden and initially served as rental property. In 1946, Huff & Haden proposed a subdivision of the parcel into six small lots--two on Lankford (the preexisting houses at 100 and 102), with a twelve-foot alley and the other four lots fronting on First Street Extended. Although the subdivision was approved, it appears that the property was never actually divided according to plan. Instead, when George and Sarah Brooks acquired 100 Lankford (lot 2) in 1958, they also obtained portions of lots 3, 4, 5, and 6, creating a larger (.346 acre) holding. The house is a typical mid-twentieth-century dwelling of a form often seen throughout the historically African-American neighborhood east of Ridge Street. In 1976-1977 the house was remodeled (approx. \$8,700 in improvements), including

a bedroom addition. Since 1977, the property has been owned by Bertha M. Cooper. 


