Mary Joy,

I want to let you know that we are reinstalling the original front doors on each of our 4 entrances and removing the storm doors. The original front doors have to be hung to swing out as opposed to swinging in (as they did when they were first installed). The doors will have the original brass hardware plus a brass push button lock for tenants to use. They will be painted Charleston Green, as they were before they were stripped. I have contacted Alexander Nicholson to do all the work and am waiting on their proposal. As there are no changes to the doors except for the legal requirement to have them swing out and the addition of a lock for our tenant's security, I don't expect that we need to involve BAR. Please confirm.
