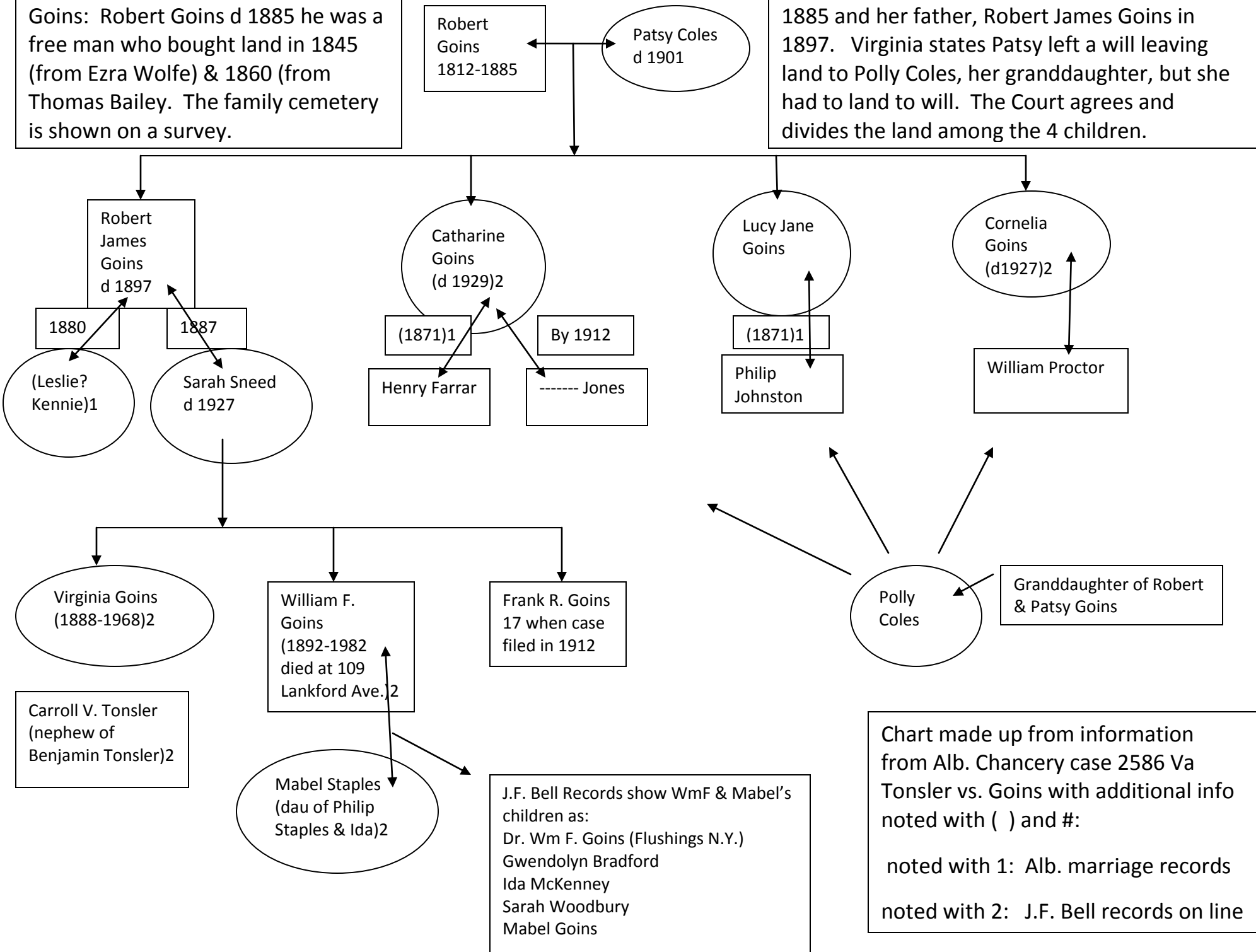


Alb. Chancery case 2586 Tonsler vs. Goins: Robert Goins d 1885 he was a free man who bought land in 1845 (from Ezra Wolfe) & 1860 (from Thomas Bailey). The family cemetery is shown on a survey.

Virginia Tonsler states her grandfather died in 1885 and her father, Robert James Goins in 1897. Virginia states Patsy left a will leaving land to Polly Coles, her granddaughter, but she had to land to will. The Court agrees and divides the land among the 4 children.
