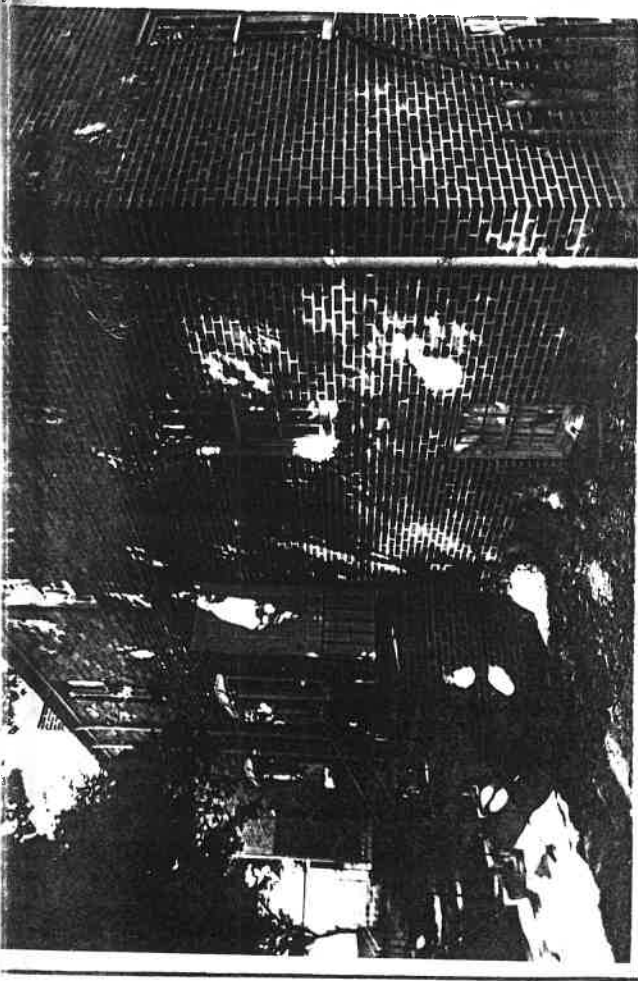

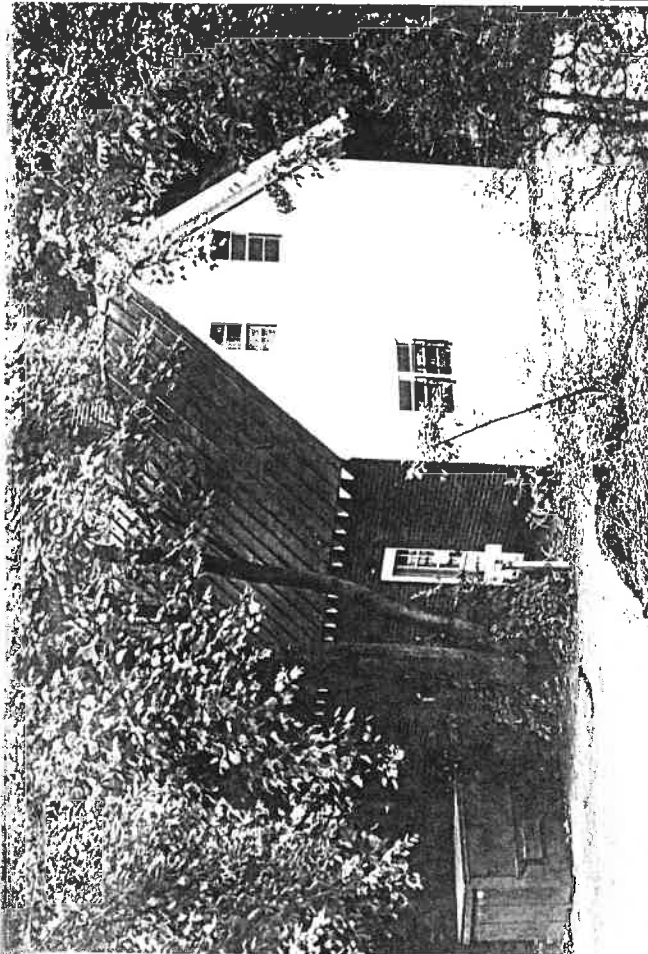

This small house sits well back from the street, all but hidden from it by thick woods. Access is via a drive from Grady Ave., not from 15th St.

Built of cinder block, it is sheathed with brick on the two lateral facades, and board-and-batten on the south gable end, where a large bay window overlooks the woods.
