I need to replace the roofing on my house and would like move from asphalt shingle to metal and from a dull grey to either red, silver, or white. I have chosen energy efficient materials and finishing with a high reflectivity index. They are all Energy-Star qualified. I would also like to replace the existing metal gutters with copper half-round gutters, which are more in fitting with the neighborhood and the original construction of the house. The other features of the roof would remain the same.

411 Altamont Circle

I attach several photos of my house and the surrounding houses and apartment buildings to give you an idea of the visual environment.

Nearly all the roofs in my neighborhood are either stone or metal. Changing from asphalt shingle to metal would thus help my house fit in better with the surrounding buildings. Also, as you can see from photos 2 and 5, the two houses behind mine that you see when looking at my house straight on, have red roofs. The color change I hope to make would harmonize with them. If, for some reason, the red I have chosen is not accepted, I would like approval for the silver and white. I prefer the silver but it is more expensive and I may not be able to afford it. Although it would be my first choice if the red is turned down, I may have to go with the white instead. If all three are unacceptable, I will replace the light grey shingle with new light grey shingle and would probably not replace the gutters with copper half-rounds.
