Mary Joy,

My house is almost a square. The front (& back) measures 30' 6" and each side measures 31' 2". That makes the SQ footage about 945.5. The addition out the back is proposed at 16' x 16 feet (256 sq ft.) There is a full basement under the whole house that previous owners used in their living space. I only use the rooms for an office and storage. I went up on the front porch of the house across the street and assessed that I would not be able to see the roof of the addition. Its ridge will be well below the main ridge of the house. I can bring pictures when we meet and you are welcome to see the site anytime.

I spoke with Reid Broadhead on the phone (while he was looking at the plat) and he did not think there would be an easement issue as long as we did not go any closer to the property's side edge than the existing house. After you have a chance to look things over, I will certainly run more complete plans by him.

I am available anytime on Wednesday after 10:00. Just choose something that works with your schedule and I will come to the planning offices at the annex and show you what I would like to do.


