I understand the gutters as the Philadelphia gutters can be problematic long term (although with all the trees around their house so are half-rounds) - don't see need for a ridge vent if the attic as through ventilation. Any idea if the house will be air conditioned? - if so I would argue for insulating the roof system and conditioning that attic.

Roof Replacement

Replace existing standing seam tin roof, currently painted red and rusted through in numerous locations, with new standing seam copper roof. Existing panels are 17". New copper panels will be 21". Replace existing Philadelphia gutters with half-round brown aluminum gutters. Add ridge vent. Replace sections A, B, and C on rear of house with rubber membrane.
