Attached please find the renderings for the awnings in Cooper Black Sunbrella for 300 East Market St forwarded at the request of Carole Thompson.

The scale of the renderings is accurate. The bottom of the awnings will clear 8'0". The valance cut is shown as straight in these renderings. There are 2 sets of renderings and 2 sizes. One as a smaller 2'4" drop and one with a 3'6" drop. The construction and style is consistent with the other awnings in the neighborhood. The awnings will be 12" wider than each window. This allows for 6" on the right and left side to reduce the chance that the brick will spall off when the anchors are drilled in.

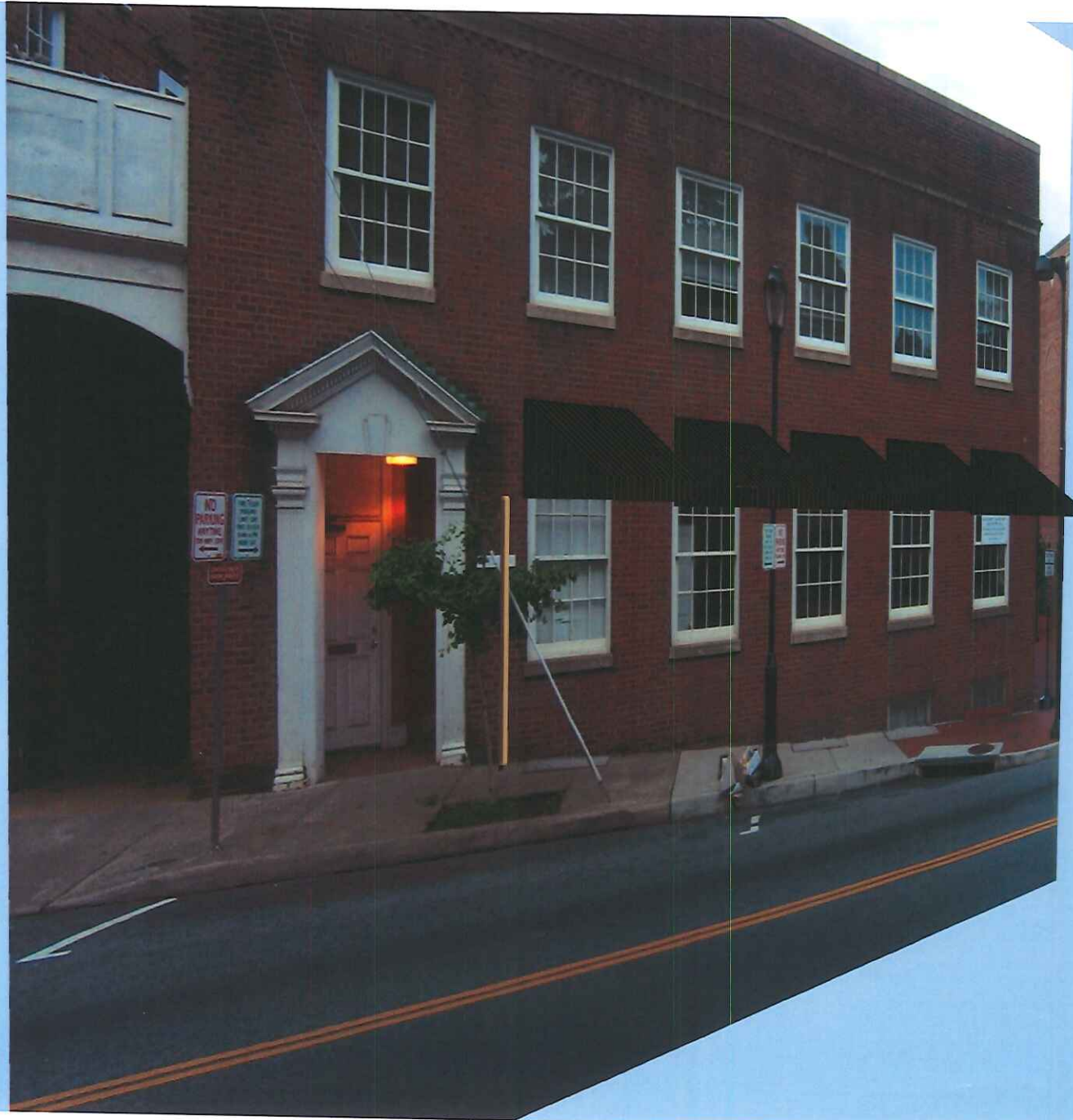
