



The following picture is of an awning that Dodson installed at 109 Water Street, who will also install the awning for 420 W Main Street. The awning that we would like to install will look very similar to this with a straight fascia. The material will be a Sunbrella fabric. (you can look up the company online, they have a lot of colors to choose from). We will pick a color that will match the color of the new banding around the building.



The following picture is a picture of the goose-neck fixtures that we are planning on installing above the band, centered over each of the three garage doors. We will also two on the band over the store front, one centered over the door and one on the cantilever. We will have to use rigid conduit to provide power to these fixtures. We will paint the conduit the same color as the background. The name of the fixture is the Original Warehouse Goose-neck Light, manufactured by Barn Light Electric. The finish is galvanized steel.



The patio will be resurfaced with a product called Concrete Revive, manufactured by Gulf Synthetics. We plan on making the patio the same color as unfinished concrete. Our concrete contractor is also looking into the option of pouring a concrete topping slab, that will be left as a natural finish, with no added color.

The client is waiting for the graphic designers that she hired to finish the design of the signage for the restaurant. We will use a color from their color-palette to paint the band on the building. I will show you the options for you to approve before any decisions are made.

I will apply for a sign permit when we get specifications for the signage from the graphic designer.

We are planning on pouring footings for the rail and the addition on Monday, if it is possible to release the permit tomorrow so that we can get footing inspections. Tell me if there is anything else that you need specifications on for this project. I will run all of these materials and fixtures by you before we order or install anything that was left for you to approve.
