ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION This structure with Colonial Revival veranda is basically a simple design of the traditional 3 bays wide, 2 story high, with a tin hipped roof popular in the post-bellum period. The most interesting feature of the house is its porch which is supported by columns with Gibbs surrounds (the practice of "pulling out" bands of stone to emphasize the structure. It was made popular by the early eighteenth century English architect James Gibbs).			
HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION The lot was purchased by Mary A. Minor from Drury Wood, the commissioner for C. H. Almond, in 1873 for \$295.55. When the lot was sold to Polly Gilmer in 1877, the value had jumped to \$3,000 making it clear that the house was built shortly after the Minor purchase.
