There is a center front gable, adorned with a decoratively pierced circular attic vent (which appears on side gables also). The shed-roofed front porch with square post supports, sawn brackets, and a post-and-rail balustrade shelters the entryway. The windows on the front elevation are two-over-two double-hung sash, while many others in the building are six-over-six. A one-story gabled rear ell matches the front section in materials and detailing. Condition: Good Threats to Resource: None Known Additions/Alterations Description: One-story shed frame extension to rear ell. Evidence on exterior siding of recent blown-in insulation.

### Relationship of Secondary Resources to Property:

Both outbuildings original or early (ca. 1920) to property; among the most decorative in the neighborhood. Privy: frame construction with weatherboard siding, decorative circular vent (matches vent on house), bracketed gable overhang, six-light sash, and exposed rafter ends. Office: frame, on brick pier foundation; one-story, with modern wood siding and two-leaf door in gable front elevation sheltered by hipped stoop.

### Significance Statement:

The house at 932 Fifth Street, SW is one of six dwellings completed in 1917 as Cook Addition, a section of rental houses built on Berring and Fifth streets for property owners Fred and Christiana Cook, who lived nearby on Ridge Street. The lot appears as lot no. 1 in a 1920 plat of the addition. The lot was purchased from Christiana Cook by Arthur and Sallie Brown in 1927. Arthur died ca. 1976, and the property was owned by his widow until 1995. This example is typical of the one-story, three-bay houses often built in the neighborhoods adjoining Ridge Street in the early twentieth century.
