This one-story, three-bay, weatherboarded frame house on a foundation of brick piers with later infill is a typical early-twentieth-century dwelling with a rectangular form, topped by a side-gable roof with asphalt rolled roofing. There is a center front gable above a shed-roofed front porch with square post supports and turned balusters. Windows are two-over-two double-hung sash, and exposed rafter ends decorate the front gable and porch.

Significance Statement: The house at 934 Fifth Street, SW is one of six dwellings completed in 1923 as Cook Row, a collection of houses built on Fifth and Linden streets as rental property for Fred and Christiana Cook, who lived nearby on Ridge Street. In 1924, the Cooks sold the house to T.F. and Mamie Meeks, who returned ownership of the property to the Cooks after defaulting on a loan. The Cooks then sold this house, along with two others south of it, to W.A. Crawford in late 1924. The house has had a succession of owners since then, including Walter and Clara Stevens, who acquired the property in 1962 and sold it twenty years later to the present owner, James Mozee. The dwelling is typical of the one-story, three-bay houses often built in the neighborhoods adjoining Ridge Street in the early twentieth century.
