ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

This one-story automotive building is set back from the street, behind a paved parking area from which a masonry ramp spirals up and around the building's, southwestern front corner to give access to a parking area on the concrete roof. Wall construction is cinderblock. The facade is seven bays wide with an entrance in the second, a garage door in the third, and industrial-sash windows in the other five. There are 4-light, hinged-sash windows in the cinderblock wall below the ramp.
