ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The walls of this tall one-story building are constructed of a cinderblock, painted gray. The front portion of the northern side wall is faced with horizontal siding. A plan parapet concedes a flat roof. On the facade, there are a garage door, an industrial sash window (painted over), and an entrance door, with brick surroundings between them. There are four huge glass-brick windows on the southern elevation.
