Description:

This two-story, two-bay, double-pile, aluminum-sided frame house on a solid brick foundation is typical of the houses built on Berring Street. The standardized form, one room wide by two rooms deep, incorporates a slight setback between the front and rear rooms. A one-story shed-roofed wing on the east side of the building may be a replacement of the original kitchen wing, which would have been similar to the wings still evident at 320 and 322 Berring. Two-over-two double-hung sash are used throughout the house.

The shed-roofed front porch has had its original wood posts replaced with wrought metal supports. The exterior of the house has been clad in aluminum siding, and aluminum storms have been installed at door and window openings.

Significance Statement:

The house at 324 Berring Street is one of six dwellings completed in 1917 as Cook Row, a collection of rental houses built on Berring and Fifth streets for property owners Fred and Christiana Cook, who lived nearby on Ridge Street. The lot is identified as lot no. 3 in a 1920 plat. This example is typical of the two-story houses built in the neighborhoods adjoining Ridge Street in the early twentieth century.



Roof

- paint coating on standing-seam-metal roofing has deteriorated; some evidence of rust and deterioration of metal on portions of roof
- inappropriately detailed and poorly repaired flashing at east chimney has introduced severe moisture damage to unit C
- building has inadequate rainwater distribution system, with no gutters, downspouts or other drainage to direct water safely away from building
- no roof insulation

Interior

General

- no electrical wiring
- no lighting fixtures
- no HVAC systems
- no plumbing
- wood flooring in fair to poor condition throughout (damaged by moisture and insects)
- deteriorated paint surfaces throughout; paint probably lead-based (health hazard)
- storage of agricultural-related materials throughout
- animal refuse, decayed plant materials, and dirt/grime throughout

Parlor/Chamber (A)

- plaster finish mostly deteriorated on stone chimney face
- moisture damage to wood sheathing near chimney and door and window openings
- arched stone lintel over firebox has large crack and may be structurally compromised
- window opening in west wall blocked with metal panel; sash missing
- window opening in north wall has inappropriately sized sash and is partially boarded up
- southwest corner--daylight comes through
- wide cracks between tongue-and-groove sheathing boards due to shrinkage
- tongue-and-groove sheathing boards have very rough surface finish
- exposed daubing on east (log) wall in fair condition

Hall (R)

- southeast corner batten strips inappropriately replaced during former repairs
- some batten strips insecurely attached and missing historic handwrought nails
- open "stove pipe" hole above mantel
- firebox opening blocked
- recessed, cased chimney breast has inappropriate vertical-board sheathing treatment
- window in south wall missing glass panes, but 4/4 muntin pattern intact
