Description:

This one-story, three-bay, aluminum-sided frame house is a typical early-twentieth-century dwelling with a single-pile form, topped by a gable roof of asphalt shingles with a center front gable feature. An integral one-story ell extends behind the house. The house's foundation is of poured concrete. The one-story, three-bay, shed-roofed front porch has Craftsman-influenced supports comprised of brick piers with tapered square columns. The balustrade is a later addition. The windows throughout the house are six-over-one double-hung wood sash, paired on the front elevation and single elsewhere. The central front entry incorporates a paneled wood and glass door.

Additions/Alterations Description:

The aluminum siding is an addition to the exterior, as are aluminum storms at window and door openings. A one-story rear shed addition fills the reentrant angle formed by the house and ell. The front porch balustrade, originally probably wood, has been replaced with a wrought metal balustrade.

Significance Statement:

Built about 1930, this house has been owned by Ollie T. Woodfolk, Jr. since 1946. The building is a near-copy of the Mary M. Woodfolk House, located next door at 234 Hartman's Mill Road, which was built by Ollie T. Woodfolk, Sr. Ernestine Woodfolk acquired part ownership of the house in 1976 and full ownership in 1991. The Woodfolk House is typical of the one-story, single-pile dwellings built in the historically African-American neighborhood east of Ridge Street during the early twentieth century.
