The two poultry houses (for raising pigeons) are situated near the rear property line of the house, at a good distance from the dwelling. They are of frame construction with shed roofs and screened cages that are raised by supports to about four feet above the ground.

DHR Historic Context: Domestic Ethnicity/Immigration

Significance Statement:

The Tonsler-Ford House is a typical mid-twentieth-century dwelling of modest size and architectural detail. It is one of the more common dwelling types found in the historically African-American neighborhood east of Ridge Street. Built as a rental property for Lawrence and Estelle Tonsler about 1945, it has been owner-occupied by the Ford family since 1951. In that year, the Tonslers divided their property (the western half of Lot 4 in the Robert Goins estate), which included this dwelling and the adjoining one at 106 Lankford, and sold off "Lot 4-B" as depicted on a 1951 plat to George and Lula B. Ford.
