The house is sited on a narrow, deep lot that slopes only slightly from front to rear, where it adjoins a wooded creekbed. A narrow right-of-way along the west side of the property leads to the Goins family cemetery, located at the extreme southwestern corner of the lot. No markers are visible at the cemetery site; presumably they were of wood and have decayed over time. Numerous mature specimen trees (deciduous and evergreen), including hemlock, Norway spruce, Southern magnolia, American holly, and old fruit trees are present on the property; several form a screen along the western boundary of the property. In addition, numerous mature shrubs, including American boxwood and English boxwood, are present on the property. A low retaining

wall of riverstones and concrete blocks, with steps that connect to the house's back door, retain the rear yard near the site of a former garage. A short front walk of poured concrete leads to the front porch from the street, and an asphalt driveway along the east side of the dwelling ends at a modern metal carport attached to the house.

The house has a central brick flue, and the two-bay front porch has stuccoed square-post supports. A lattice-like balustrade of interlocking concrete blocks decorates the otherwise plain porch. A decorative vent in the front gable, boxed cornices, cornice returns, and simple window trim provide the principal architectural detailing of the house. The windows throughout the house are two-over-two double-hung wood sash.

Condition: Good Threats to Resource: None Known

Additions/Alterations Description: Stucco has been added to the walls, over the original weatherboard siding, and two rear shed additions (of same materials and detailing) have been made beyond the original footprint of the house. The porch supports and concrete block "latticework" balustrade are relatively modern alterations also.

Interior Description:

The original plan of the house was of a side-passage, single-pile form. The principal interior features include the staircase, with turned balusters and ornate newel posts, wooden pilastered mantels in original first and second floor rooms, four-panel wood doors, and elaborate architrave moldings at door and window openings. Plaster walls and ceilings, with wood flooring, were the original finishes. After the Tonslers acquired the property in 1942, they added several rooms onto the back of the house, including a kitchen, a dining room, a den, two bedrooms, and a bathroom. Some walls have been covered with paneling, others with wallpaper, but several rooms retain original finishes.

Relationship of Secondary Resources to Property:

In the southwest corner of the property, about 200' behind the house, is the Goins family cemetery. According to plats from 1912 and 1951, the graveyard is about 35' square and is accessed by a narrow right-of-way along the west edge of the property. At the end of the driveway, just in front of a mature tree, is the stone foundation of the former detached garage. The foundation is clearly visible and encloses an area approximately 9'wide by 12'deep.

DHR Historic Context: Domestic Ethnicity/Immigration Funerary

Significance Statement:

The Cornelia G.B. Proctor House was apparently built about 1910, or shortly after the 1912 division of the estate of Robert Goins. Sanborn Insurance Maps show the building on its site by 1920. The building is a typical early-twentieth-century two-story single-pile house in the historically African-American neighborhood east of Ridge Street, with good integrity. Cornelia Proctor was a daughter of Robert Goins, who was among the earliest African-Americans to establish small farms in the area east of Ridge Street. The Goins family cemetery, presumably where Robert Goins and other family members are buried, is located on this property, a portion of "Lot No. 4" as conveyed to Cornelia Proctor in 1912.
