ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

A very simple square, two story brick structure with a hip roof and irregularly arranged fenestration. The first floor openings have segmental arches while the second floor windows extend to the flat, wooden cornice. The simple Doric columned veranda relieves the flatness of the facade and adds an air of symmetry to the house.

HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION

William and Staurula Pappas purchased the property at 107 West Market Street in 1925 from George Gilmer (DB 51-226). R. T. Seabrook bought this lot and the one next door at 113 West Market Street from J. E. Irvine and W. O. Watson in 1906 (DB 18-28). He had the house built about 1910. George Gilmer purchased it from Seabrook in 1916 (DB 28-320). The house is now the residence of William Pappas' son Gus W. Pappas.
