



#### 5. Description of physical appearance:

The Kappa Alpha Fraternity house is a basic  $2\frac{1}{2}$ -storey, 3-bay, double-pile Georgian Revival house with a 2-storey projecting pavilion at the rear. Walls are veneered with brick laid in stretcher bond. The high-pitched gable roof is covered with slate and has a boxed cornice with returns. There are three interior end chimneys with caps and stringcourses.

The buildings windows are double-sash, 6-over-6 light, with paneled shutters. Those at the second storey level are somewhat shorter. There are three dormers with pedimented gable roofs on the facade and a single shed-roofed dormer with three windows on the rear elevation. A large circular headed window with Gothic tracery centered on the rear elevation lights the stair. A small one-storey entrance porch covers the central bay of the facade. Two Tuscan columns support a segmental-arched gable roof with a dentiled cornice and plain frieze. The 6-paneled entrance door has sidelights and a semi-elliptical fanlight.

#### 6. Statement of significance:

Among other things, the Rugby Road-University Corner Historic District is important because of the large number of historic and/or architecturally significant fraternity houses located there. Built mainly between 1910 and 1940, the houses represent an important aspect of student life at the University of Virginia.


The Kappa Alpha Fraternity House is one of the finer examples of the domestic use of the Colonial Revival style, which makes up the bulk of the fabric of the Rugby Road/University Corner Historic District. The architect is unknown and it is quite possible that the design came from a pattern book; but the house is quite well proportioned and is nicely detailed. The semi-elliptical-arched entrance, the handsome chimney and the large window in the stair hall are particularly noteworthy.





Windows are double-such, 6-over-6 light, with france shallers. Those at the second storey level are some-what shorter. A a mall one-storey entrance porch covers the central bay of the facade. Two Tuncan columns support a regmental-arched gable roof with a dentify cornice of plain frieze. The 6-paneled entrance door has sited sidelights of semi-ellystical fanlight.

I one-storey pianga covers most of the southern end of the go house. It has a plain fringe, required pullar & a simple balistrade

It was recently rebuilt + extended to the rear as an open deck with matching beliefrade.

There are three dormers with pedimented gable roofs on the facade a single shed-roofed dormer with three windows on the rear elevation. A large circular-headed window with bothir tracery centered on the rear elevation lights the stair.
