Behind and down-slope from the house along Berring Alley are two outbuildings. Closest to the house is a small brick building missing its gable roof that may have served as a coal shed or utility building. Further down is a brick foundation for a former garage.

Significance Statement:

The building contributes to the historic character of Ridge Street. Brothers Eston (b. 1870) and Byrd Updike, partners in the Monticello Brick Company, built the house and moved in the same week as the Rotunda Fire at UVA in 1895. The brothers lived in the house with their wives (Eston's wife was Etta Margaret) and families. The brothers also built the house next door to the north (located in the existing historic district) as well as houses on 7-1/2 Street.

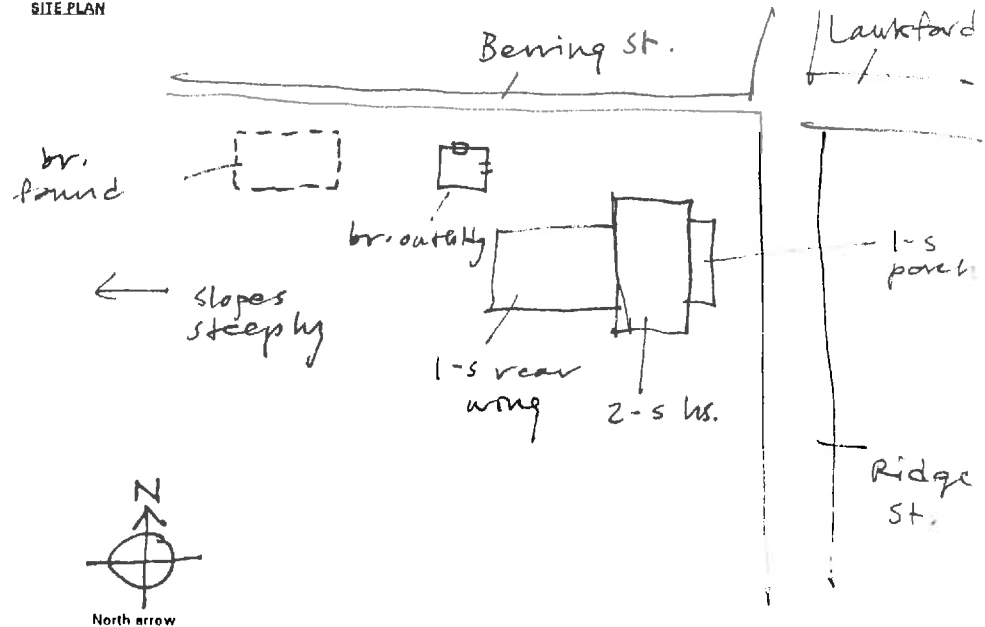
