This railroad overpass is constructed of poured concrete and has an arched underpass. The parapet sides are about 4 feet high and have a molded cap. At either end of the bridge are a pair of decorative cast-concrete obelisks with metal urns atop.

Historical information

This bridge replaces an earlier, wooden one in the late 1920s or early 30s. The earlier bridge was used for streetcars as well as motor vehicles.

Since the early 1960s it has served as an unofficial student bulletin board, being painted (usually at night with graffiti and artwork. Having been repainted several times a month for the past two decades, it is now covered in hundreds of layers of paint.
