Revival Georgian/ shingle style. c.1900. staggered pattern shingles in pediment, tuscan columns and turned ballustrade on porch. central bay entrance. 2/2, door with transom light. 1 exterior west chimney. front stairs removed to west side of porch, 2 story rear addition.
