#### **Background**

410 East Water Street is a contributing structure located in the Downtown ADC. The courtyard has historically served as a warehouse loading area with multiple loading docks for the transfer of dry goods. The property owner is in the process of making improvements to the building. The BAR approved a rear window replacement and street tree replacements in August 2003. Staff has recently administratively approved a wrought iron fence in the rear parking lot; and the repainting some doors and trim.

#### Application

The proposed work will not change the existing brick openings, but will enlarge the glass area in three openings. The work proposed replaces the existing fixed windows with one operable entry opening and two fixed openings with the specifications as follows:

1 entry door: provide new ¼" clear insulated tempered glass with 1" clear insulated glass sidelights at either side as per drawing and specification, provide classic bronze anodized aluminum finish

2 fixed openings: provide new 1" clear insulated tempered glass with sidelights at either side as per drawing and specification, provide classic bronze anodized aluminum finish

#### **Discussion**

#### **Review Criteria Generally**

Sec. 34-284(b) of the City Code states that,

In considering a particular application the BAR shall approve the application unless it finds:

- (1) That the proposal does not meet specific standards set forth within this division or applicable provisions of the Design Guidelines established by the board pursuant to Sec. 34-288(6); and
- (2) The proposal is incompatible with the historic, cultural or architectural character of the district in which the property is located or the protected property that is the subject of the application.

#### Pertinent Standards for Review of Construction and Alterations include:

- (1) Whether the material, texture, color, height, scale, mass and placement of the proposed addition, modification or construction are visually and architecturally compatible with the site and the applicable design control district;
- (2) The harmony of the proposed change in terms of overall proportion and the size and placement of entrances, windows, awnings, exterior stairs and signs;
- (3) The Secretary of the Interior Standards for Rehabilitation set forth within the Code of Federal Regulations (36 C.F.R. §67.7(b)), as may be relevant;

#### Description of work:

Replace the three half windows back to full glass (with bronze dividers) for better light, street visibility, and to return these large industrial loading dock, openings to a shape that better illustrates their original use.

As late as 1980 the Courtyard was a warehouse loading area with multiple docks for trucks and with workman and dry goods going in and out with frequency. Returning these openings to visually more their original shapes will enhance the building. Similarly, please note that the middle of the three windows can be modified in the future for direct access to the courtyard . We understand ARB approval would be necessary for any future stairs.




