WHEREAS, the City of Charlottesville has a pending action against the defendant Joe H. Gieck Trust in the Charlottesville Circuit Court, Case No. CL-10-000360-00, seeking damages based upon an unauthorized demolition of a historic structure; and

WHEREAS, based upon the facts and circumstances of the case, a reasonable settlement of the matter has been negotiated amongst the parties to the action, including a donation to the City in the amount of sixteen thousand dollars and issuance of a formal public apology and statement by the defendant; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City to settle and conclude this matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that the settlement of the Circuit Court case referenced herein in exchange for a donation to the City in the amount of sixteen thousand dollars and issuance of a formal public apology and statement by the defendant is approved.

RESOLUTION APPLICATION TO LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND ACQUSITION OF HARTMAN MILL FOR PARKLAND \$100,000

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation offers a Land and Water Conservation grant, and

WHEREAS, the owner of the land on which the old Hartman Mill stood has offered the entire property (approximately 20 acres) for sale to the City, and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlottesville supports extension of trails, preservation of open space and forest lands, stream valley protection, and interpretation of historical resources, and

WHEREAS, the Hartman Mill property offers all of the above and is a large parcel with long frontage on Moore's Creek, and

WHEREAS, the City land acquisition fund would be supplemented by this grant to help cover the purchase cost;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that the City apply for Land and Water Conservation funding for the purposes of acquiring and protecting the property containing the old Hartman Mill for public outdoor recreational and park uses; and

BE IT FURTHER RRESOLVED that the property will be put under federal section 6(f) protection for public outdoor recreational use in perpetuity if acquired using Land and Water Conservation funds.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND APPROVING THE CITY MANAGER'S EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council for the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that Section 6 ("Salary") of the City Manager's Employment Agreement between the City of Charlottesville and City Manager Maurice Jones, dated December 7, 2010 and amended December 19, 2011, is hereby amended to increase the City Manager's annual base salary by two percent (2%), effective November 7, 2011. All other terms and conditions in the Employment Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF CHARLOTTESVILLE'S 2012-2013 HOME FUNDS \$91,742

WHEREAS, the City of Charlottesville has been advised of the approval by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development of HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) funding for the 2012-2013 fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the region is receiving an estimated award of \$592,683 for year nineteen or fiscal year 12-13 in HOME funding of which the City will receive an estimated \$74,085 to be expended on affordable housing initiatives such as property acquisition and housing rehabilitation.

WHEREAS, it is a requirement of this grant that projects funded with HOME initiatives money be matched with local funding in varying degrees;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that the local match for the above listed programs will be covered by the Charlottesville Housing Fund account CP-0084 in SAP system) in the estimated amount of \$17,657; the resolution for this appropriation with come forward after July 1, 2012. Program income from previous FYs amounts to \$0 available for FY 12-13. The total of the HUD money, program income, and the local match, \$91,742, will be distributed as shown below. Administrative funds for the year total \$3,457, which do not require a City match.
