Two questions about our property on W. Main:

- 1. The parging material and colors approved by the BAR for Pizza Hut will continue across the front of the building, but we would like to simply re-paint the 10th Street façade CMU with the approved color scheme (rather than parging). Do you forsee any issues with this plan and does it require an amendment? If so, is it administrative?
- 2. Some of the rooftop equipment is located outside the screen perimeter shown on the plan.
