- State Historic Markers: One on the Baptist Church on West Main Street and one dealing with Jack Jouett's Ride. There was a discussion of the text on the markers.
- Local Historic Markers: There was a discussion as to how these markers should be designed. Neal Gropen, a local sign maker, presented alternatives for local markers. He showed samples of metals and stone. There was also a discussion of the first local marker at Vinegar Hill. It was agreed that the Committee will meet on July 8, 1998 at 4:00 p.m. at the Mall Entrance of the Omni Hotel.
- **<u>Historical Booklet:</u>** Fred Heblich is taking the lead in preparing a brief history of Charlottesville.
- Exhibits about Local History: An exhibit in City Hall and the Train Station were discussed.

Ms. Cass Cannon showed an original letter from Queen Charlotte and asked where this kind of historic document should be displayed.
