January 2020: These two houses are both two stories, located on the east side of 10th Street NW. The one closest to the street is a duplex, 336 A-B 10th Street NW, and the one at the rear is 336 C 10th Street NW.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to City of Charlottesville Property Records, both of these buildings were built in 1950 and have been owned by the same family since their construction (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). This building first appears on the 1950 Sanborn Map, along with the rear house on the lot, and they both have the same footprint they have today (Sanborn Map Company 1950; USGS 2017).

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, material, and workmanship have been mildly compromised through exterior material changes. This property retains excellent integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource and one contributing secondary resource.

January 2020: The two-story duplex rests on a concrete foundation, is clad in vinyl siding, and has a cross-gabled roof covered in asphalt shingles. There is an interior, brick, double chimney at the ridgeline in the center of the roof. The front (northwest) façade features a full-width, one-story, open porch with a shed roof supported by wood Doric columns with wood railings. This porch is accessed by concrete stairs. There are two entrances on this facade, both situated to the north of the porch. There is a secondary entrance on the rear (southeast) elevation accessed by wood stairs with wood railings. There is also a two-story wood deck on this elevation accessed via wood stairs with wood railings. Visible fenestration includes a fifteen-light, single-leaf, wood door; a single-leaf, wood door with a metal and glass storm door; one-over-one, doublehung, metal windows; six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl windows, some with metal storm windows.
