January 2020: This one-and-a-half story house sits on the west side of 10th 1/2 Street NW. The front of the property is lined by boxwoods. The rear of the lot is surrounded by a chain link fence. There are large trees to the southeast and southwest of the property, and there is no real slope to the property. The property consists of a house and a shed in the rear.		
Surveyor Assessment:		
January 2020: This property was built in 1942 according to the city of Charlottesville Property Records (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). This dwelling was built on Lot 22 and 22 ¹ / ₂ of the John West Lots, purchased by John West in 1885, according to City of Charlottesville Property Records (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020; ACHS n.d.). These lots were bought from West by Stephen H. Key c. 1916 (ACHS n.d.). This dwelling first appeared on the 1950 Sanborn Map, but without either the front portico or the rear enclosed porch, which were built between 1950 and 1994 (Sanborn Map Company 1950; USGS 1994). Due to scale and vegetation, it is difficult to identify these features on aerial photographs.		
This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship have been mildly compromised with the porch and portico additions. This property retains excellent integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.		
This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource and one non-contributing secondary resource.
