Site Description:

January 2020: This one-story house is located on the east side of 12th Street NW, between Gordon and Grady Avenues. It is fairly set back on the lot compared to its neighbors, with mature trees in the back yard. There is a gravel driveway in the north corner of the lot, along the northeast property line. There is a chain link fence along the southwest property line and a wire fence along the northeast property line. This property consists of a house.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to the Charlottesville City Property Records, this house was constructed in 1940 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). It is visible on the 1950 Sanborn Maps as a one-story, square-shaped dwelling with a one-story outbuilding at the rear of the lot. At the time, its address was listed as both 414 and 506 12th Street NW. The front entry porch was built by 1964 (Sanborn Map Company 1950; NETR 1964). The outbuilding was demolished between 2000 and 2002 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020).

This property retains good integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship has been slightly compromised by replacement siding and windows. The property retains good integrity of feeling and association, despite the loss of the historic outbuilding. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource.

January 2020: This one-story house rests on a concrete foundation, is clad in aluminum siding, and has a gambrel roof that is covered with asphalt shingles. There is an interior brick chimney on the southwest roof slope. There is a one-story porch at the southwest end of the northwest-facing facade. The porch rests on a concrete block foundation, has metal filigree columns, and a hipped roof. It provides access to the main entranceway via concrete steps. Visible fenestration consists of one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl windows; a single-leaf wood door with a fanlight and a metal storm door.
