According to Sanborn Maps, the one-story stucco clad portion of the house that is sited closest to the street (northwest) appears to be original, while the rear (southeast) two-story portion is all a modern addition (Sanborn Map Company 1950). The original main block is clad in stucco and has a side gable roof clad in green asphalt shingles with exposed rafter tails. A one-story, partial-width, open-air porch is located on the façade. The hipped roof porch is supported by wood posts. The main block has an exterior-end brick chimney on the southwest elevation. The addition consists of a large two-story portion on the rear of the main block, and a one-story, hipped roof porch on the western corner, that serves as the entrance to the addition.
