Site Description:

January 2020: This two-and-a-half story duplex is located on the east side of 8th Street NW on the north corner of 8th Street NW and Page Street, formerly known as Elsom Street (Sanborn Map Company 1950). The site has a slight downward slope along Page Street. This property consists of a duplex.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to Charlottesville City Property Records, this duplex was constructed in 1948 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). This is supported by the Sanborn Maps, since the dwelling first appears in the 1950 Sanborn Map with the same footprint as today, including the one-story, open, engaged porches on either corner of the rear elevation (Sanborn Map Company 1950; USGS 2017). This property was owned by Elver Dent from 1979 to 2005 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020).

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship for this property has been mildly compromised by replacement windows. This property retains excellent integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource.

Architectural Description:

January 2020: This two-and-a-half-story duplex rests on a concrete block foundation, is constructed of concrete block with brick quoins and a denticulated brick cornice around the whole building, and has a hipped roof covered in asphalt shingles. There are two, interior, brick chimneys located on the northeast and southwest roof slopes. The front (northwest) facing façade features two entrances, one on the north and one on the south end. These are accessed by concrete block and brick stoops with concrete steps and metal railings. Above the entrances, there are hipped roof awnings clad in asphalt shingles with wood brackets. This façade also features a hipped roof dormer clad in stucco. The rear (southeast) elevation has a projected front gable wall dormer. This elevation also features two entry porches, to either side of the wall dormer. The porches have wood decks with wood railings and a wood column, that supports a shed roof covered with asphalt shingles. The porches are accessed by concrete block steps with wood railings surrounded by vinyl latticework. Visible fenestration includes two-light metal awning windows; sixover-six, double-hung, wood windows some with metal storm windows; six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl windows, some with metal storm windows; four-light, single-leaf wood doors; and three-light, single-leaf wood doors.
