Site Description:

January 2020: This two-story house is located on the west corner of Paoli Street and 9th Street NW. The house is sited on a slightly slope that descends to the south. There is a low, concrete-block retaining wall along the southeast property line and concrete block piers at the entrance to the house. There are small bushes in the front yard and a large tree near the north corner of the lot. There is a garage along the northwest property line that is accessible from Paoli Street. This property consists of a house and a garage.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to Charlottesville City Property Records, this house was constructed in 1925 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). However, the house first appears in the 1920 Sanborn Map with the same footprint that is evident in the other Sanborn Maps – indicating it was likely built prior to 1920. By 1929, a full-width, one-story rear addition was built (Sanborn Map Company 1920; Sanborn Map Company 1920). The one-story, small, open porch on the northeast elevation appears in the 1920 Sanborn Map and still exists today (Sanborn Map Company 1920; USGS 2017). At the northwest corner of the two-story portion of the house, a second-story addition was constructed at an unknown date. This house has almost the same roof structure and footprint as 214 and 208 9th Street NW and was likely constructed at the same time (USGS 1994; USGS 2017). The garage along the northwest property line first appears in the 1950 Sanborn Map Company 1950). This property has been owned by Lewis and Lucille Anderson since 1963 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020).

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship has been compromised by replacement siding and windows. This property retains good integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource and one contributing secondary resource.

Architectural Description:

January 2020: This two-story house sits on a stretcher bond brick foundation, is clad in aluminum siding, and has a hipped roof with lower cross-gables covered with standing seam metal. The front-facing gable projects slightly from the rest of the house. There is an interior, central, brick chimney located in the center of the crosses on the ridgeline. The front (southeast) facing façade features a full-width, one-story, open porch with a hipped roof. The porch roof is supported by turned wood columns with spindlework along the cornice line and bracketing, and the porch has metal railings. The porch is accessed by wood stairs with wood railings, and rests on a concrete block foundation with basement windows. The main entrance to the house is located at the north end of this façade. The rear (northwest) facing elevation includes a two-story, shed roof wing in the northwest corner of the two-story portion, as well as a full-width, one-story, asymmetrical gable roof addition. This addition features a partial-width open porch in the center of its northeast elevation. The porch is supported by square wood posts. Visible fenestration includes a single-leaf, wood door with a metal and glass storm door and a transom with sidelights; and two-over-two and four-over-four, double-hung, wood windows, some with metal screens.
