January 2020: This one-story house is located on the north side of Anderson Street, west of 8th Street NW. The southwest side of this property line has a low brick retaining wall that continues along the adjacent properties. This front yard is also filled with vegetation, as is the backyard, obscuring most of the building. There is a vehicle shed in the east corner of the lot and a wood fence along the rear property line. This property consists of a house and a shed.

#### **Surveyor Assessment:**

January 2020: According to Charlottesville City Property Records, this house was constructed in 1941 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). This is supported by the Sanborn Maps, since the house first appears on the 1950 Sanborn Map with the same footprint it has today, along with a vehicle shed in the northeast corner of the lot, which remains extant (Sanborn Map 1950; USGS 1994; USGS 2017)

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship has been compromised by replacement windows and cladding. This property retains good integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource and one contributing secondary resource.

#### **Architectural Description:**

January 2020: This one-story house sits on a concrete block foundation, is clad in asbestos siding, and has a side-gabled roof covered in asphalt shingles. There is an exterior brick chimney on the southeast elevation at the ridgeline. There is a front-gabled wing at the west end of the southwest-facing façade. To the east of the wing, the façade also features a partial-width, one-story, shed-roof porch supported by square wood columns with wood picket fence-style railings. The main entrance is in the center of the porch and is accessed by concrete steps with metal railings. There is an interior brick chimney on the northeast roof slope. The rear (northeast) elevation features a partial-width front-gabled projection. It has a shed roof awning near the center over a rear entrance (USGS 2017). Visible fenestration includes three-over-one, double-hung, vinyl windows, some with metal storm windows; and a single-leaf, wood door with a fixed light.
