January 2020: This two-story house sits on a brick foundation, is clad in aluminum siding, and has a hipped roof with lower cross gables covered in asphalt shingles. The front-facing gable on the southwest façade projects slightly forward from the rest of the house. The façade also includes a full-length, one-story, open porch with a hipped roof covered with standing seam metal. The porch roof is supported by turned wood columns with gingerbread trim. The porch rests on brick piers, has turned wood railings, and is accessed by brick steps with brick railings. The main entrance is at the east end. All of the gable ends include decorated vergeboard and are clad in fish scale, wood shingles. There is a long, full-width, one-story front-gabled wing on the rear (northeast) elevation. The roof is covered in standing seam metal. This wing has an interior brick chimney on the ridgeline. The southeast elevation of this wing has a secondary entrance that is accessed by fieldstone steps. Visible fenestration includes one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl windows, some with metal screens; a vinyl picture window flanked by vinyl casement windows; a vinyl sliding window; a single-leaf wood door with a metal and glass storm door; and a single-leaf, wood door with a transom and sidelights, and a metal and glass storm door.
