**Site Description:** 

January 2020: This two-story house is located on the north side of Page Street, between 7th and 8th Streets NW. It has a short brick retaining wall along the southwest property line, a gravel driveway along the southeast property line, and a concrete sidewalk along the northwest property line. The backyard is surrounded by a hewn wood fence with metal gates. There are small bushes dotted throughout the lot. This property consists of a house.

#### Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to the Charlottesville City Property Records, this house was constructed in 1940 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). However, the property first appears on the 1920 Sanborn Maps as a two-story dwelling with a one-story, full-width, open porch, indicating that it was built earlier. By 1929, a partial-width, one-story, open porch was built on the southeast end of the northeast elevation (Sanborn Map Company 1920; Sanborn Map Company 1920). Prior to 2019, the rear porch consisted of a concrete patio. It was then replaced by the present-day structure with a second-floor balcony (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). For several decades, this property was owned by the Brown family, including William and later Emma, likely his wife (Hill Directory Co. 1931; Hill Directory Co. 1940; Hill Directory Co. 1959). It is unknown if they are related to the owners of 705 Page Street down the block.

This property retains good integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship has been compromised by replacement siding and windows, and the construction of the rear porch in 2019. This property retains good integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource.

#### **Architectural Description:**

January 2020: This two-story house rests on a brick foundation, is clad in vinyl siding, and has a cross-gabled roof that is covered in asphalt shingles. The southwest-facing façade features a full-width, one-story, open porch with a hipped roof. The porch, which rests on brick piers, is accessed by concrete and brick stairs at the east end, to provide access to the main entrance to this house. This porch roof is supported by square wood columns and has Chippendale wood railings. The rear (northeast) elevation features an open porch supported by square wood columns with a second-floor balcony surrounded by wood railings. Visible fenestration includes one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl windows; vinyl casement windows; a single-leaf wood door with nine lights; wood French doors; and a single-leaf wood door with a single light, a metal and glass storm door, and a transom.
