Social History

Thomas Bridgeford, an African American waiter and his wife Mattie Bridgeford lived in the house from 1927 until their deaths in the 1950s. Lenora Bridgeford, their daughter, inherited the house and lived there during the 1960s.

Statement of Significance

This single-family dwelling was primarily owned and occupied by one family throughout much of the 20th century. While, some of the original fabric of the house has been replaced with modern materials, the site holds social and community significance.

2020: This property is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource.
