January 2020: This one-story, multi-use, commercial building is located on the south side of Preston Avenue between 10th and 9th Streets NW. The rear of the property is surrounded by a chain link fence. There are parking lots on both the northwest and southeast sides of the building, and the building spans from Preston Avenue to West Street. This property consists of a long commercial building and a small shed.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to City of Charlottesville Property Records, this property was built in 1950 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). According to the 1950 Sanborn Maps, the northernmost part of the building was built in 1949 (Sanborn Map Company 1950). The rear addition of the building was constructed sometime between 1950 and 1963 (NETR 1963). The property has been owned by the same family since 1983, George and Shirley Rennick, which became Rennick Properties, LLC in the early 2000s (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). The shed in the rear of the property was constructed in 2008, according to aerial photographs (USGS 2007; USGS 2008). As of 1959, this building housed Jarman Printing Co., Allied Arts, and Town and Country Food Center Inc (Hill Directory Co. 1959).

January 2020: This slightly L-shaped commercial building sits on a concrete foundation, is clad in painted concrete block, and has a flat roof with metal coping. The front (northeast) facing facade features storefront windows that wrap around both sides of the building. There are two concrete chimneys near the center of the northwest elevation. On the northwest and southwest elevations, there are concrete block pilasters. The east leg of the L-shape contains a laundromat, with entrances on the northeast and southwest elevations. Visible fenestration includes large metal storefront windows; metal picture windows; metal and glass single-leaf and double-leaf doors with transoms; and single-stall rolling metal garage doors.
