January 2020: This one-story house is located on the north side of Rosser Avenue East. The site slopes downhill towards the north and the rear of the building. There are small box hedges in the front yard and mature trees in the back yard. There is an asphalt parking pad at the east end of the property, bordered by a wood picket fence. This property consists of a house and a shed.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: 2020: According to the City of Charlottesville Property Records, this house was constructed in 1940 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). However, it first appears on the 1929 Sanborn Map as 206 Rose Avenue or Preston Avenue NW as one of a series of similarly footprinted houses built in 1925 (Sanborn Map Company 1929). The rear open porch visible in the 1929 and 1950 Sanborn Maps was half enclosed at an unknown date (Sanborn Map Company 1950; USGS 1994; USGS 2007; USGS 2017).

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship for this property have been mildly compromised through exterior material changes, the partial enclosure of the rear porch, and replacement windows. This property retains excellent integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource and one non-contributing secondary resource.

January 2020: This one-story house rests on a concrete foundation, is clad in vinyl siding, and has a side-gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles. There is an interior brick chimney on the ridgeline. The front (south) facing façade features a one-story, full-width, open porch with a shed roof supported by metal filigree posts. The porch roof is covered in standing seam metal. The main entrance is located in the center of this facade. The north (rear) elevation has a full-length wing with a shed roof, the west half of which is enclosed while the east half is open and supported by a square wood column on a concrete block retaining wall. Visible fenestration includes two-over-two, double-hung, wood windows with metal storm windows; and a single-leaf, wood door with one light and a metal bar and glass storm door.
